

ment from any Shop-keeper or other Person, with Flourifles or Devices in the Margin, or any Number thereon in white Letters or Figures, on a black or dark Ground, or shall use any fuch Plate fo engraved, cut, etched, or feraped in Metzotinto, or shall use any other Instrument for the making or printing any fuch Promissory Note, Inland Bill, or Bill of Exchange, or blank Promissory Note, Inland Bill, or Bill of Exchange, or Notice or Advertisement; and if any Person, without being authorized and appointed as aforefaid, shall, after

after the First Day of June, in the Year of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-feven, knowingly have in his, her, or their Custody, any fuch Plate or Instrument, or shall knowingly and wilfully utter or publish any fuch Promisfory Note, Inland Bill, or Bill of Exchange, blank Promissory Note, Inland Bill, or Bill of Exchange, or utter or disperse any such Notice or Advertisement, every fuch Person so offending in any of the Cases aforefaid, and being convicted thereof, according to

Law, shall be fined in any

Sum not exceeding Fifty Pounds, or be committed to the common Gaol of the County, or Place where the Offence shall be committed, for any Space of Time not exceeding Six Months.

Provided always, and it is hereby Enacted, That fond to Perfous hereafter nothing herein contained, possessed of fuch Notes or shall extend, or be construed Bills, and who to extend to any Person or Means to Perfons who, being at any compel Pay-Time hereafter possessed of any fuch Note or Bill, shall only utter the fame, by carrying the fame for Payment to the Iffuer or Iffuers, Drawer or Drawers, Acceptor or Acceptors, Indorfer

Provided always, and tend to Notes be it Enacted, That nothing dated before herein contained shall in 1 June, 1797, faveas herein, any Sort extend, or be construed to extend to any Promissory Notes or Bills of Exchange, executed dated before the First Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-feven, or to prevent or affect the uttering, negociating, receiving or paying the fame, fave only by the Makers thereof.
